ENTRY RULES

Entries must be original to artist and not derived from another Artwork. Maximum size for paintings is 5' x 5'. Artwork must have been completed in last 3 years, sculpture in last 5 years. Artist receives 70% of sale price and HAL receives 30%. Glass is allowed in framed Artwork seven hundred (700) square inches or smaller, otherwise Plexiglas is required on larger pieces. Unframed Artwork is allowed only with painted edges. All photographs to be framed under glass or Plexiglas. Large framed and unframed paintings must be wired with wire ends wrapped in tape. Wire should be securely attached to the back with appropriate hardware, one-third down from frame top. Wire needs to stretch to not less than 2" from top of art. Smaller pieces may be hung by the type of device meant for that frame. The Art Center reserves the right to reject Artwork that is deemed to be too difficult to hang safely. Mats, glass, and Plexiglas need to be clean and free of scratches. All Artwork MUST have an official label attached to the back upper left-hand corner. No reproductions (prints) except photos and original digital prints. No AI generated Artwork will be accepted. Artwork must have not won any previous awards in an Art Center exhibition. Artwork weighing over 50 lbs. will be accepted at the discretion of the receiving committee, and the artist must be available to assist with placement of the piece the day the work is hung. Artwork may not be removed from exhibition to be sold, shown in another exhibit, or substituted with another piece during the exhibition dates. Maximum of three entries per member artist. Artwork sold will remain in the Art Center Gallery until the published pickup dates. Artists are encouraged to offer at least one Artwork for sale, but NFS (Not For Sale) entries are accepted. Sculpture and Pottery are eligible. Crafts and Jewelry are not eligible. Entry fees are non-refundable. We guarantee at least one work will be accepted into the show if it meets the criteria (hanging, medium, etc.) If Artwork is sold during the exhibition, the Artist will receive a check for their portion from the Art League on the day of pickup. The Art League will charge the customer sales tax and submit that to the state. Artwork must be picked up on the designated pick-up dates. Artists who leave their Artwork at the Art Center longer than seven (7) days after the pickup dates will be charged \$5 per day per piece. Highlands Art League, Inc. will do everything possible to protect the Artwork of the artists during the exhibition process, however Highlands Art League, Inc. cannot be responsible for loss or damage. All Artwork will be hung at the discretion of the Executive Director. The Art Center reserves the right to decide how and where the Artwork is hung or displayed in the exhibition. Artists will be notified (phone or email) if for any reason their Artwork is not accepted and needs to be picked up.
